



ACTIVITY RATES

Valid from 1st January 2025 to 31st December 2025

BOAT HIRE

During the flood season (April to June), the boats are moored at our lodge, which will then have direct access to the Zambezi River. During the dry season, the boats are moved to the lodge mooring spot on the main Zambezi River, which is about 8 kilometers from the lodge. When boats are needed from the mooring spot on the Zambezi River, guests can either drive their cars down to the boats or pay an extra N\$50 per person return (a minimum of 2 people) to take the lodge bus.

Fishing/Birding Trips

- Dory Boats 4.5m – can carry 3 people in comfort.
- Aliboat Swamp Cruiser 6m – can carry up to 6 people in comfort.

Please Note the Following:

- Boat hire includes a guide – no boat is to be driven by private individuals.
- Boat hire EXCLUDES fuel, except for the sunset cruise rate.
- Boat Hire for fishing trips excludes fishing licenses. These must be obtained from the lodge before the guest embarks on the trip. (N\$50.00 – valid for 1 month).
- Boat hire excludes drinks, tackle (purchase from the shop), fishing rods (hire cost N\$100 each), bait, ice, etc.
- For full-day rental, a lunch box can be provided for each guest at an extra cost.
- If the boat is booked and confirmed and not used, the client will still be charged for the hire.

****PLEASE NOTE THAT BOATS SHOULD BE BOOKED IN ADVANCE DURING THE HIGH SEASON.**

PONTOON HIRE

A large pontoon on the lake in front of the lodge is available for hire. This boat is only used on the backwater unless arrangements are made with the management before leaving (only when the Zambezi is flooding and there is entry to the river at the bottom of the lake).

Sunset Cruise - N\$ 450 per person (Minimum 2 people)

Sunset Cruise - N\$ 400 per person (Minimum 4 people)

Pontoon Dinner - N\$500 per person (Minimum 8 people)

- All Pontoon hire for fishing trips excludes fishing licenses. These must be obtained from the lodge before the client embarks on the trip. (N\$50.00 – valid for 1 month).

TRADITIONAL MAKOROS

Traditional Maoros on the Lake in front of the Lodge This is an adventurous activity for those wishing to experience some of the local culture.

Hire Rates:

Per hour - N\$ 250 per Person (Max of 2 people)

Please note

- Children U12 years are to be accompanied by an adult & maximum 2 guests per Makoro
- Lifejackets (personal floatation devices – PFDs) are recommended but children U12 years old are required to wear one.

CANOES

CANOES (Guided or Un-guided) – on the Lake in front of the Lodge NB. The lake is part of the Zambezi River System where wild hippos and crocodiles often frequent. Guests using the canoes are urged to exercise extreme caution when on the water and they do so at their own risk. The lodge has 4 x double Canadian canoes for use by guests. This is an ideal activity for those who wish to get up close to birds for photography or who want to get some exercise after having spent many days in a car.

Hire Rates:

FREE FOR RESIDENT GUESTS ONLY FOR NON-RESIDENTS, THE FOLLOWING RATES APPLY

Per hour - N\$ 250 per canoe

3-5 hours – N\$ 600 per canoe

Full day – N\$ 850 per canoe (from 07h00-18h00)

All Canoeing Guests – Please Note the Following:

- Children U12 years old are to be accompanied by an adult.
- Unaccompanied children 13 years -16 years are only allowed in the channel in front of the lodge and are not to paddle out to the main lagoon.
- Lifejackets (personal floatation devices – PFDs) are recommended but children.
- U12 years are required to wear one. Please note that they are not meant as cushions.

Lifejackets are obtainable from the main office. Please Note the Following:

- All Pontoon hire includes a guide – no boat is to be driven by private individuals.
- Pontoon hire EXCLUDES fuel.
- All Pontoon hire for fishing trips excludes fishing licenses. These must be obtained from the lodge before the client embarks on the trip. (N\$50.00 – valid for 1 month).
- All Pontoon hire excludes drinks, tackle (Purchase from the shop), fishing rods (Hire cost N\$90 each), bait, ice, etc.
- For full-day rental, a lunch box can be provided for each guest at an extra cost. If the pontoon is booked and confirmed and not used, the client will still be charged for the hire.
- The Pontoon can also be hired for functions. Should the guest request, a braai (barbecue) can be put on board for meals.

DAY TOURS

Day tours can be organized to either Bwabwata National Park in Namibia, Chobe National Park in Botswana or Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe. Prices on request

VILLAGE TOURS

Take a walk to a nearby village (approximately 1km from the lodge) to experience the community of a traditional African village. The tour is approximately 2 to 3 hours and the majority of this fee is paid back to the village.

Hire Rates:

N\$300 per adult

N\$150 per child U12 years

Please note that this tour is to a village where a whole community lives so please remember to respect the customs and traditions of the people.
