



ACTIVITY RATES

Valid from 1st January 2026 to 31st December 2026

BOAT HIRE

During the flood season (April to June), boats are moored at the lodge, providing direct access to the Zambezi River. During the dry season, boats are moved to the lodge's mooring spot on the main Zambezi River, approximately 8 kilometers from the lodge. When boats are needed from the mooring spot on the Zambezi River, guests can either drive their own cars down to the boats or pay an extra N\$50 per person return (a minimum of 2 people).

Fishing & Birding Trips

Boat Hire Rates

Half Day - N\$2,400 (Max 5 hours Morning or Afternoon)

Full Day - N\$3,190 (Max 9 Hours)

Sunset Cruises

N\$450 per person (Minimum 2 people)

N\$400 per person (Minimum 4 people)

Important Notes:

- Boat hire includes a guide – no boat to be driven by private individuals.
- Boat hire EXCLUDES fuel, except for the sunset cruise rate.
- Boat Hire for fishing trips excludes fishing licenses. These must be obtained from the lodge prior to the guest embarking on the trip. (N\$50.00 – valid for 1 month).
- Boat hire excludes drinks, tackle (purchase from the shop), fishing rods (hire cost N\$100 each), bait, ice, etc.
- For full-day rental, a lunch box can be provided for each guest at an extra cost.
- If the boat is booked and confirmed and not used, the client will still be charged for the hire.

PONTOON HIRE

A large pontoon on the lake in front of the lodge is available for hire. This boat is only used on the backwater, unless arrangements are made with management before departure (only when the Zambezi is flooding and there is access to the river at the bottom of the lake).

Large Pontoon – (min 4 people/max 25 people + guide)

Hire Rates – Half Day N\$2,940 (Maximum 5 hours in the morning or afternoon)

Full Day N\$3,720 (Maximum 9 hours)

Sunset Cruise - N\$450 per person (Minimum 2 people)

Sunset Cruise- N\$400 per person (Minimum 4 people)

Pontoon Dinner - N\$500 per person (minimum 8 people)

Please Note the Following:

- All Pontoon hire includes a guide – no boat to be driven by private individuals.
- All Pontoon hire EXCLUDES fuel.
- All Pontoon hire for fishing trips excludes fishing licenses. These must be obtained from the lodge prior to the client embarking on the trip. (N\$50.00 – valid for 1 month).
- All Pontoon hire excludes drinks, tackle (Purchase from the shop), fishing rods (Hire Cost N\$100 each), bait, ice, etc.
- For a full-day rental, a lunch box can be provided for each guest at an extra cost.
- If the pontoon is booked and confirmed and not used, the client will still be charged for the hire.
- The Pontoon can also be hired for functions. Should the guest request, a braai (barbecue) can be put on board for meals.

CANOEING

CANOES (Guided or Unguided) – on the Lake in front of the Lodge

NB. The lake is part of the Zambezi River System, where wild hippos and crocodiles often frequent. Guests using the canoes are urged to exercise extreme caution when on the water, and they do so at their own risk.

The lodge has 4 x double Canadian canoes for use by guests. This is an ideal activity for those who wish to get up close to birds for photography or who want to get some exercise after having spent many days in a car.

FREE FOR RESIDENT GUESTS ONLY

FOR NON-RESIDENTS, THE FOLLOWING RATES APPLY

Per hour - N\$ 250 per canoe

3-5 hours – N\$600 per canoe

Full day – N\$ 850 per canoe (from 07h00-18h00)

All Canoeing Guests – Please Note the Following:

- Children under 12 years are to be accompanied by an adult.
- Unaccompanied children 13 years -16 years are only allowed in the channel in front of the lodge and are not to paddle out to the main lagoon.
- Lifejackets (personal floatation devices – PFDs) are recommended but children.
- U12 years are required to wear one. Please note that they are not meant as cushions.
- Lifejackets are obtainable from the main office.

TRADITIONAL MAKOROS

TRADITIONAL MAKOROS – on the Lake in front of the Lodge

This is an interesting activity for those wishing to experience some of the local culture.

Per hour - N\$250 per Person (Maximum of 2 people)

- Children under 12 years are to be accompanied by an adult & maximum 2 guests per Makoro
- Lifejackets (personal floatation devices – PFDs) are recommended, but children under 12 years are required to wear one.

VILLAGE TOURS

Take a walk to a nearby village (approximately 1km from the lodge) to experience the community of a traditional African village. The tour is approximately 2 to 3 hours, and the majority of this fee is paid back to the village.

N\$300 per adult

N\$150 per child under 12 years

Please note that this tour is to a village where a whole community lives so please remember to respect the customs and traditions of the people.

DAY TOURS

Day tours can be organised to either Bwabwata National Park in Namibia, Chobe National Park in Botswana or Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe. Prices on request.
